Budget

- Governor Brown released his budget proposal in January.
 - Increase in funding per pupil
 - o Eliminate deferrals
 - o Common Core Implementation Grant

• The California State Legislature will discuss budget priorities through the spring, and key economic indicators will be updated in May before a final plan is adopted.
