1. Discussion and possible approval of P P P Loan Application

Discussion by the board members included the following:

At the June 20, 2020 Village Charter Academy Board Meeting the Board approved submitting the PP Loan Application. If approved, the Board would decide to accept or not accept PPP loan based on the impact on the approved State Budget of 2020-2021.

Village Charter Academy's future fiscal status changed significantly after the June 20th meeting with the approval of the budget by the Legislature. One of the elements in the approved budget was the use of the ADA figures for the current school year not 2020-2021 ADA. Due to the fact that our enrollment is increasing potentially by 20-30 students in the coming school year, we are faced with increasing class size and laying off staff due to a loss of \$300,000, in addition of the difficult challenges of deferrals at the same time.

... This application for PPP funding is based on protecting the payroll of teachers and instructional assistants. The rationale for our submission is clearly protecting our payroll and not "double dipping" as the State is not providing funding for the teachers and staff due to our enrollment increase of 20-30 students.

... We are clearly within the intention of the PPP grant with the grant funds
